### **To Pursue:**

- Plaids, esp. mixing plaids
- Balancing large, bold shapes with soft textures
- Sofa Florals
- Polka Dots with pastel or quiet colors

### **Main Colors:**

- Red
- Ducks
- Brown


### To avoid:

Texas Orange - Chocolate - Metallic Gold - Metallic Silver even split








## **COLOR TRENDS 2: Unicorn**

**Dk. Pink and Mint** 










### **Color Trend: Red**

### **Color Trend: Red Variations**

Raspberry (Burgendy) as a winter accompaniment to Red. Last year it was Cranberry, this year it is Raspberry.





Raspberry works well with Ducks, Mint, Red, and Dk. Pink.





Berries as a base to highlight an accent.





Red makeup as an accent. Perhaps could be applied to pattern accent colors.



### **Color Trend: Ducks**

Ducks is prevelant, emerging from the Red-Blue summer trend, the tiki trend, and the growing interest in the 80s.





# Color Trend: Texas Orange and Brown

A Fall and Winter response to the popularity of Gold over the last few years as well as a muted Boho influence.





### **Color Trend: Metallic Gold**

Pushing the popularity of Gold to the extreme, possibly it's trend conclusion.











### **Color Trend: Metallic Silver**

Reintroducing Silver! The Gold-Silver oscillation may be beginning.
This is also influenced by the late 90s/early 00s trend
by referencing back to Millenium fashion.





### **Color Trend: Pink**

The Lt Pinks of 2016/17 are changing to brighter and warmer tones, such as Spice and Ultra Pink.





## Floral Update

Tiki Florals, Victorian Florals, and the 90s influence are giving way to Couch Florals, which are folklike, large, simplified flower patterns.









# Floral Update (cont)

Pastels (but with Red or Raspberry accents) reign.





# Trend: New Americana (Southwest Hipster)

Texas, Southwest, and Country styles with millenial sensibilities.

This is especially expressed through line work, pattern repetition, and mixing fibers. The trick is to explore and develop American history without ironicizing outdoor labor or heritage (like the insensitive PRPS Jeans).







# Trend: New Americana (cont.)





### **Trend: Soft Power**

A mixture of performance outdoors fabrics, businesswear, or sculptural fabrics with soft formal fabrics.





## **Trend: Plaid**

Plaids, all shapes, sizes, lines, references. Browns and Tx. Orange are particularly present.





# Trend: Plaid (cont.)

Blacks, Whites, and Greys color pallets Mixing of different sizes and types of plaids.







## **Trend: Polka Dots**

Polka dots, but quiet layouts with dots serving as a unifying factor.







# Trend: Polka Dots (cont.)

Can become an offset quiet moment to contrast bold or busy patterns.

Large fields of polka dots are especially effective.





# **Bright Geometric**

Like quilts made with Illustrator, the Geometric Patterns have evolved to become statement pieces with bright colors offset with dynamic lines. Especially present in retro, 1950s influenced, and DIY/Etsy scenes.








### **Other Patterns**
